2. Main areas of responsibility :

Monitoring and development of the EU-IMF economic adjustment programme for Ireland:

- Analysing and reporting on economic and financial developments and policy conditionality in the context of the programme, including on the macroeconomic framework, programme financing and financial-sector, budgetary and structural reform policies;
- Contributing to effective communication on the programme, including at national level;
- Maintaining contacts with the Irish authorities, international financial institutions and central banks, and other relevant stakeholders, including during review missions to Dublin;
- Developing the Commission's policy strategy on the Irish programme, including during the post-programme period;
- Economic surveillance in the context of the Stability and Growth Pact, the EU 2020 strategy and the macroeconomic imbalances procedure.

3. Main qualifications :

The successful candidate should have proven experience as a well-rounded macroeconomist and/or policy advisor with the following qualifications, experiences and competencies:

- Strong analytical skills, proven by an advanced university degree in (macro)economics;
- Outstanding judgement and problem solving skills;
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English with an ability to identify and address complex policy issues in non-technical terms and to engage effectively in high-level policy discussions;
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work and co-ordinate effectively in parallel on a number of areas on diverse topics while meeting tight deadlines.
- Work experience on programme countries and/or knowledge of statistical/econometric techniques for analytical and forecasting purposes would be an asset.

4. Languages:

The seconded national expert must have knowledge of two Community languages. English is the main working language at DG ECFIN.
