Status of implementation of the programme




Results of the Call 2005



37 proposals recommended for EC funding

Maximum EC funding: ~11.79 M€





Call 2006



Draft Work Programme and call for 2006 already published on programme web site

Provisional date for publication of definitive versions: July 2006.

Provisional deadline for receipt of proposals 29 September 2006.

Legal entities from Candidate countries can submit proposals, but selected projects can receive EC funding only if MoU in force
