Audiovisual policy

General framework

Television without Frontiers Directive



- main objective: internal market for TV-broadcasts
- means: country of origin principle
- consequences: co-ordination of basic principles

Scope of the Directive



Television broadcasting initial transmission (air, cable, satellite) in unencoded or coded form intended for reception by the public

NOT included: information or other messages on individual demand

Objectives of general interest



- Right to information
- cultural diversity
- consumer protection
- protection of minors and public order
- > right to reply

Basic principles



- ➢One MS has jurisdiction over a broadcaster
- **➤ Control by originating Member State**
- ➤ All other Member States must ensure freedom of reception

Clear criteria to determine the originating Member State



- Broadcaster is established in the EU
- Broadcaster is not established in the EU but programmes can be received



- > Head office
- Editorial decisions on programme schedules
- Significant part of workforce



1. Head office in MS A

editorial decisions MS A

- \rightarrow MS A
- 2. Head office in MS A editorial decisions in MS B
 - → MS with significant part of workforce



- 3. Significant part of workforce in MS A and MS B

 → head office
- 4. Significant part of workforce neither in MS A nor in MS B
 - → first began broadcast + stable and effective link



- 5. Head office in MS A decisions on programme in a third country (or vice versa)
 - → MS (provided that a significant part of workforce)

Criteria in case there is no establishment within the EU



- Use of a frequency granted by that Member State
- Use of satellite capacity appertaining to that Member State
- Use of satellite uplink situated in that Member State

Freedom of reception



Freedom of reception and retransmission of TV broadcasts from other MS:

- no "dual" control by other Member States
- covers both direct reception and retransmission

One exception:

- infringement of rules concerning protection of minors and incitement to hatred
- specific procedure to be followed
