eContent*plus* objectives

Overall aim

to make digital content in Europe more accessible, usable and exploitable, facilitating the creation and diffusion of information, in areas of public interest, at Community level

Enabling role

... by creating better conditions for accessing, using, reusing and exploiting digital material

... in **areas of public interest**, which would not develop or develop at a slower pace if left to the market

... giving rise to data collections based on which it will be possible to build added-value products and services across Europe



Target areas - scope in 2006

- **Geographic information:** only **core** geographic information is covered (i.e. data with a direct reference to a specific location or geographic area)
- **Educational content:** focus on **formal education systems**
- **Digital libraries (cultural and scientific/scholarly content):** organised collections of digital cultural and scientific/scholarly content (*digital libraries*) made available to the public by **cultural institutions** (libraries, archives and museums)



What is funded

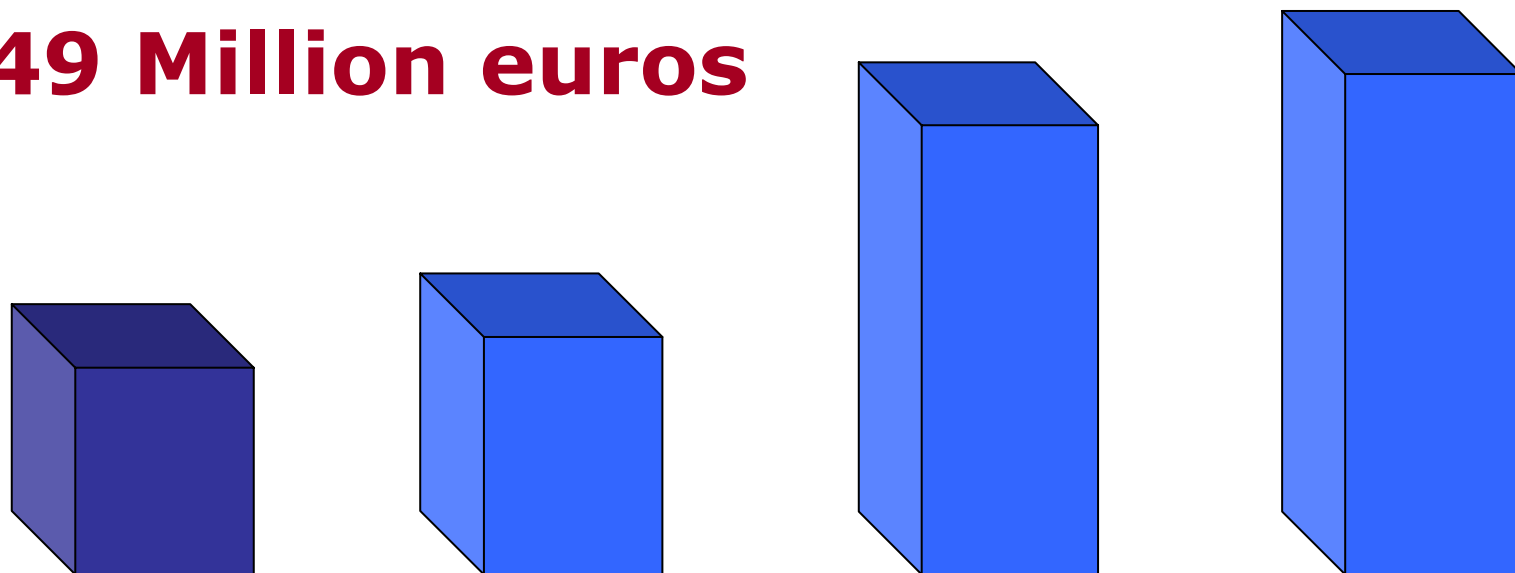
Projects that:

- aim at improving the searchability and usability of **existing** digital content in order to create the **conditions** for the emergence of European content-based services,
- use **proven state-of-the-art** technical solutions,
- are geared towards **innovation in organisation and deployment** of digital content (as opposed to purely technological innovation),

How to join eContentplus

Through a Bilateral Agreement with the Commission (**Memorandum of Understanding** – MoU) defining:

- Terms & conditions for participation
- Financial contribution

Invitation to join the programme sent in spring 2005

- To launch procedure, **confirm interest in writing**



After joining the programme

- National organisations are eligible to participate in projects with Community funding
- A delegate can represent the country at programme Management Committee meetings

- as from 2009 – eContentplus
