Before « Culture 2000 » ...

A certain number of initiatives since the 1980-ties, such as:

- 1. European cities of culture since 1985
- 2. Kaleidoscope: programme (1996-1999)
- 3. Raphael: cultural heritage (1996-1999)
- 4. Ariane: reading, books and translation (1997-1999)

Not part of the *acquis communautaire* (cf. Eur-Lex 16.40 – Culture)

Main Features of the Programme

- Global budget of approx. 240 million EUR (2000-2006)
- Internal programme open to: Member States, members of the EEA, acceding/candidate countries
- Multiannual programming (2000-2006)
- Transnational cooperation the area of culture
- Target group: cultural operators
- Focus on the achievement of concrete projects of cultural cooperation





The Aims of the Programme

- Facilitate intercultural dialogue
- Encourage artistic creativity and mobility
- Disseminate the knowledge about the history of European peoples
- Strengthen the role of culture as a social integration factor as well as a socio-economic development catalyst
- Promote the access to art and culture

Performing arts

Visual arts

Cultural Heritage

Books and reading, including translation

Multidisciplinary creativity

Cultural cooperation in third countries

Action 1: Annual Co-operation Projects

Action 2: Multi-annual Projects within Cooperation

Cultural Contact Point (1)

The C'2000 programme is run centrally by services of The Commission, unlike education programmes

CCPs: unlike in other programmes, which are facilitated through national agencies, the CCP role is to disseminate information about the programme and to enhance the participation of cultural operators in co-operation partnerships





Cultural Contact Point (2)

Role defined in Annex I, point V of Decision nr. 208/2000/E

Aim: promote the programme, facilitate access to it and encourage participation in its activities by means of an effective dissemination of information

Co-financing from the programme budget through contract concluded with the Commission

The new « Culture 2007 » Programme (2)

A third generation programme with three main features: a broad reparation, a budgetary increase, important simplification fforts

The programme proposes to be more open in geographical erms (Western Balkans) and in trans-sectoral co-operation term. The 3 transversal objectives of the new programme: to promote

he transnational mobility of people working in the cultural ector, to encourage the transnational circulation of works and ultural and artistic products, to encourage intercultural dialogue

Initially the EUR-15 MS could make proposals for cities in turn (cf. list in Annex I)

Art. 4 allows for third countries to present candidacies for ECOC.

A new Commission proposal is being debated in the Council and in the EP: practically, will change the designation process from the 2013 onwards.

No third country candidacies for ECOC from 2011 onwards.
