

## The EC-US and EU-Canada Cooperation Programmes in Higher Education and Training



## The Agreements

The programmes are established under two formal agreements between the European Community and, respectively, the Government of the United States and the Government of Canada.



## Programme Main Objectives

**✓** Promote mutual understanding

✓ Mutually improve quality of education and contribute to human resources development



#### Who is eligible for funding?

- ✓ HE and VET institutions from the 25 EU Member States
- **✓** Organisations active in education
- ✓ EU-Fulbright: excellent post-graduate students and scholars





# Type of projects supported

- ✓Three-year consortia implementation projects
- **✓** One-year preparatory projects
- **✓** Two-year complementary activities





## Consortia Implementation Projects

- **✓** Target HE and VET instituions
- **✓** Curriculum development
- **✓** Student mobility
- ✓ Cultural and linguistic preparation



#### **Consortia Preparatory Projects**

✓ Target HE and VET institutions with little or not experience in Transatlantic cooperation



## Complementary activities

- ✓ Target organisations active in the field of education – not restricted to HE and VET institutions
- ✓ Provide support for projects dealing with horizontal issues relevant to education development
- ✓ Flexibility in the type of activities



## **Funding**

- ✓ 3 M€ per year (2,2 for US, 0,8 for Canada)
- ✓ Up to 75% of total project cost for EU partners
- ✓ Maximum € 160,000 for EU partners and \$ 210,000 for US partners
- ✓ € 80,000 for complementary activities
- ✓ € 25,000 for preparatory projects
- ✓ Partners to cover at least 25% of project cost
- ✓ Student stipend: € 700 per EU student per month and up to € 1,000 for travel



#### Selection of applications

- √ Three-step approach
  - ✓ Peer review by independent experts (May)
  - ✓ Joint Selection with the partner authorities (June)
  - ✓ Financial decision and award of grants by the European Commission (September)
