

# Community Cooperation in education and training

More than 30 years of developments



### 1957-1984: establishing the foundations

- Cooperation in the field of Vocational Training:
  - **a legal basis** in the Treaty of Rome
  - **first steps** of cooperation (1963 Decision; establishment of the ACVT; 1971 action programme; Cedefop; ..)
- Cooperation in the field of Education
  - no legal basis in the Treaty
  - First steps of cooperation: the founding acts (1974 Resolution; 1976 first action programme)
- Mainly exchanges of experiences, study visits, pilot projects, etc.. Based on non-binding texts/commitments



## 1985-1992: development of the programmes

- 1985: a turning point (Gravier Case) broadening of the definition of VET to include higher education
- Commission proposes programmes based on Decisions and art 128 (Comett (86); Erasmus (87); Petra (87); Youth for Europe (88); Lingua (89); Force (90); Tempus (90)
- Political cooperation outside programmes continues on a growing number of themes of common interest



#### 1992-2000: The post-Maastricht period

- 1992: a turning point education gains recognition, has a clear legal basis. The result of more than 20 years of cooperation!
- Legal clarification for education and VET
- Art 126 and 127 are very close

#### 1990's: Streamlining of programmes and development of political Cooperation

- Implementation of the single act/internal market, including directives
- 2 streamlining of the E&T programmes (Socrates and Leonardo)
  - the first to be opened to CEECs
- School education is included, + adult education...
- Reinforcement HE cooperation ECTS, thematic networks, institutional contracts...
- Political cooperation is being strengthened concepts of LLL, knowledge society are gaining grounds.
- The 90s prepare the ground for the Lisbon Conclusions



### 2000: The Lisbon Agenda and Education

- 2001: an historical political agreement on common objectives and a new method of cooperation (OMC)
- 2002: adoption of a work programme
  « Education & Training 2010 »
- 2003: adoption of benchmarks
- 2004: first joint Report (Council/Commission) on implementation
- 2006: adoption of second joint report
