


Defence industries represent the defence activities of companies involved in: shipbuilding, aeronautics, electronics, engines, trucks, space ...

They are in various proportions active in both civil and defence markets

European Defence industries

Their activities have remained outside of the remits of the internal market.

Willing to maintain national controls, Members States have widely invoked Art 296 (former 223) of the Treaties to derogate from EC rules.

The Commission is a member of the Steering Board without voting rights and is fully associated with the work of the Agency



European Defence Agency

Four functions:

- Defence capabilities development
- Armaments co-operation
- European defence technological and industrial base (DTIB) and defence equipment market (EDEM)
- Research and technology
