



## 2nd Pillar - The ICT Policy Support Programme

#### Single information space

#### Inclusive information society

- All Europe's citizens to benefit (trust, confidence, digital literacy)
- Services in area of public interest showing the way (quality, efficiency)

### 3rd Pillar - The Intelligent Energy Programme

- Energy efficiency & rational use of resources "SAVE"
  - Specific measures in industry & construction and for energy using products; legislative measures
- New & renewable energy sources "ALTENER"
  - Support for integration of new and renewable energy sources; legislative measures
- Energy in transport "STEER"
  - Energy efficiency and diversification in transport, renewable fuels; legislative measures

#### Participation of Western Balkans

#### Open to...

• « Countries of the Western Balkans, in accordance with the provisions to be determined with those countries following the establishment of framework agreements concerning their participation in Community programmes. » (Article 4)

#### Participation of Croatia

- Negotiation of memorandum of understanding may begin when the legal base is adopted.
- Participation will not be « à la carte »
- Croatia already participates in eContent and as an observer to the Enterprise Programme management committee (EPMC).
- Consider likely benefits (and absorption capacity) of participation.

#### Participation of Candidate Countries

- Open to:
- « Candidate countries benefiting from a preaccession strategy, in accordance with the general principles and terms and conditions... established in the respective Framework Agreement and Association Council Decisions. »

#### Participation of Turkey

- Negotiation of memorandum of understanding may begin when the legal base is adopted.
- Participation will not be « à la carte »
- Turkey already participates in the MAP, eContent and shows interest in eTENs.
- Consider likely benefits (and absorption capacity) of participation.
