# **EU Action Plan on Drugs 05-08**

The ultimate aim is to significantly reduce the prevalence of drug use among the population and to reduce the social harm and health damage caused by the use of and trade in illicit drugs



# 5 Chapters in the Action Plan

- Coordination of policies
- Demand reduction

- Supply reduction
- International cooperation
- Information, research, evaluation



# Methodology

- 46 objectives
- More than 80 actions
- Responsibility for each action assigned
- Deadline for each action
- Assessment tools/indicators
- Annual assessment by Commission
- Follow up after final assessment 2008
